- **Prosecco – Belstar Prosecco Di Valdobbiadene DOCG, NV, Veneto Italy** €28.50
 Delicate pear and melon flavours with a touch of honey and some flowers too...all in all lots of fun, the way Prosecco should be!
- **Champagne – Louis De Sacy Grand Cru Brut NV, Montagne De Reims, France** €60.00
 A dry floral scent and a slight creamy touch in the mouth. With a good finish, at this price for Grand Cru we're certain it's a winner.

HALF BOTTLE

- **Domaine Doudeau-Leger, Sancerre , Loire, France 2008** Half Btl. €15.50
 This wine comes from a small family run vineyard in the Loire. It has a good balance of fruit and acidity with a hint of grapefruit which works well with our lighter chicken, fish and salad choices.

FULL BOTTLE & GLASS

- **Domaine De Laballe, Sables Fauves, Côtes de Gascogne VDP France, 2008** €20.00
 A bright, fruity wine made by the Laudet family in South West France. Glass €4.50
- **Viticoltori Riuniti, Pinot Grigio 'Rialto', DOC Colli Euganei Italy, 2008** €25.00
 Velvety, full flavoured with fresh acidity. Taste pear, apple and a little spice. Glass €5.75
- **Max Ferd. Richter, Riesling Classic Qba, Mosel Germany, 2007** €27.00
 A classic Mosel Riesling off dry with a hint of mineral flavour. Light, delicate and pure with a lingering finish. This is delicious with our 'Meat & Cheese from the Deli' and the Seabass.
- **Domaine Schloss Gobelsburg, Grüner Veltliner, Kamptal Langenlois Austria, 2008** €24.50
 A medium body wine that is light and elegant with hints of nut and apricot. Glass €5.50
- **The Far Paddock, Pinot Gris, Marlborough New Zealand, 2007** €28.50
 This vineyard located in a cool climate, on the banks of the River Wairu (just in case you know it!) delivers a dry full bodied white with plenty of ripe fruit flavour.
- **Rosalia De Castro, Albarino, Rias Baixas Spain, 2007** €24.00
 From Galicia, an area with a rich culture of good food, wine and long meal times. Glass €5.25
 This wine is fresh and fruity with hints of lavender, grass and hay.
- **Falerio, Saladini Pilastrri, Marche, Italy (Organic) 2008** €22.50
 Organic or not, this is a super white. Coming from a lesser known region of Italy where agriculture and untamed coastline dominate, this wine reflects its origins and is full of life! It has a slight spritz with floral and pear hints and brings you to a bright and refreshing finish.
- **Domaine Joseph Garnier, Chablis, France 2008** €28.00
 Looking for a dry white? Then this is your bottle! Made by someone whose known for their skill (Jerome Garnier...in case you know him) this is light and citrusy with a touch of depth.

ROSE

- **Lisha Nelson Signature Series Rose, Paarl, South Africa, 2008** €23.50
 Ahhh Rose - For a wine that doesn't take life too seriously! This one however, is not shy on quality having won a Decanter Bronze Medal. It has a ripe, delicate red fruit flavour with crispness and pleasantly relaxed aftertaste.

With a distinctive Bordeaux flavour, this wine has delicious ripe fruit and subtle spice tones with a soft rounded finish....those tannins are kept at bay! Gold Medal Winner at Concours Mondial Paris.

- Domaine Castelnau, Merlot, Vin De Pays Languedoc France, 2007**
A subtle red - low tannins, lots of fruit and a hint of milk chocolate.

Suprisingly fresh and juicy for a Rioja but still displaying a small amount of the characteristic clay and heat. Charming, easy drinking with good body.

Flavours of cinnamon and blackcurrant. Structured with medium tannins. Vive la France!
